## DECLARATION OF SNOW EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on **February 13, 2024, at 6:00AM until February 13, 2024, at 6:00PM** a Winter Storm has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of New Britain Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Winter Storm has endangered the health, safety, and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in New Britain Borough, and threatens to create problems greater in scope than problems New Britain Borough may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of affected residents in New Britain Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned Mayor of New Britain Borough, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in New Britain Borough.

**FURTHER, I direct the New Britain Borough Emergency Management Coordinator and Manager to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.**

**STILL FURTHER, parking is not allowed on any Borough Street during this emergency in order to facilitate the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes.**

**STILL FURTHER, I authorize officials of New Britain Borough to act as necessary to meet the current exigencies of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.**

**This Declaration shall take effect immediately.**
